At their regular meeting of June 4, 2007, the Rappahannock County Board of Supervisors met and considered a citizen-initiated request that they support the designation of the Jordan River in Rappahannock County as a State Scenic River. It is our understanding that this process is initiated at the Department of Conservation and Recreation by a request from the local governing body.

The Rappahannock County Comprehensive Plan strongly supports the designation of State Scenic Rivers, and we have enjoyed a positive experience with the designation of the Rappahannock River.

Accordingly, the Rappahannock County Board of Supervisors voted unanimously to support the nomination of the Jordan River as a State Scenic River, and hereby requests that the Department of Conservation and Recreation proceed with its evaluation.
